VOTE, VOTE, VOTE

 vote by mail – get your vote in early – you can check to see if it has been received at the website for Marion County Elections. How do I apply for a mail ballot? Apply on your county supervisor of elections' website. You can also apply via email, fax or mail.

What is the application deadline? Must be mailed by 5 p.m. on Oct. 24. Your ballot has to be mailed to you within two business days after the request is received by the elections supervisor.

What is the deadline for mailing my completed ballot? Must be received by 7 p.m. on Nov. 3

Is there a place where I can drop off my completed ballot instead of mailing it? Yes. Ballots can be returned to secure drop boxes at your county supervisor of elections' main and branch offices and early voting sites in your county. Locations are available online.
